HELPFUL PRAYER WALKING TIPS

- Keep your eyes open
- Your prayer can be informal, more of a natural conversation about your neighborhood with God
- Pray for the things you see. Pray for each family as you pass their house.
- Pray that God would open your eyes to see your neighborhood and its people as he does.
- Bring your spouse, children or friend along.
- Have a conversation with each other and God about your neighborhood.

- Before your walk, read the local newspaper, paying attention to stories which affect your neighborhood.
- Don't wave your arms or pray loud and awkwardly, just take a walk.
- Carry a small rock or other object; let its presence keep you focused on prayer.
- Pray for opportunities to be a Gospel presence in your neighborhood and that God would open up opportunities for you to share the Good News.

BACKYARD BBQ TIPS:

- This doesn't have to be formal, expensive, elaborate, or perfectly orchestrated. It just has to happen.
- Invite more people than you expect to come
- Invite people more than once
- Fire up the grill, bring out the coolers and set up the bean-bags. If there are lots of kids have games or let neighbors bring theirs.
- If neighbors want to help plan, listen to their ideas and welcome their help

- Be sure that those who are already Christ followers are outnumbered, so that those who are far from Christ don't feel like they are being ganged up on
- Be yourself HAVE FUN!!
- Pay attention to the people you invite
- You should never find yourself "enjoying" the ways of the world – or participating in them
